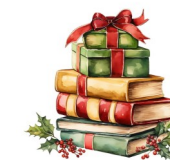

June 2026 Debt/Bank Loan for Worship Center, Music Center and Kid City



Originally the Loan was \$1,829,853.44 in November 2016
The Loan is now \$308,580.00 as of February 18, 2024.

FBC Endowment, a support organization of First Baptist Church of Tempe, services the National Bank of Arizona loan out of \$13,500.00 monthly payment from the church. With an additional \$24,000.00 of contributions each year, that loan would be fully paid off in May 2026. (And by the end of that year, a secondary loan of \$110,000.00 would also be paid off.) Payments of \$13,500 per month (\$162,000.00) can then be used to support other ministries of the church!

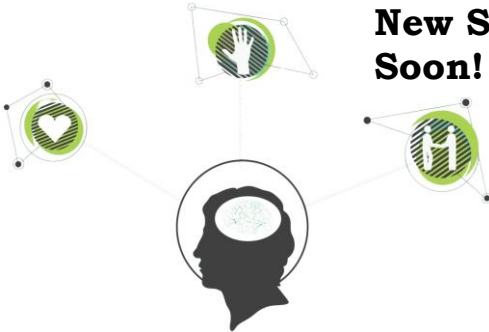

Health tips: Forgiveness

Dear Reader,

Unlike all the other organs of the body, our minds have no natural system for getting rid of waste. Hurt piles up as open files and black holes. Gratitude for what is right, compassion for suffering, accepting imperfections and focusing on life's higher meaning can all soften life's hurts. But there's one cure that can dissolve all hurt for good: forgiveness.

Forgiveness is a voluntary choice. It means that you choose to give up anger and resentment despite knowing and accepting that the misconduct happened. Forgiveness is choosing the higher path and leading a more thoughtful life driven by your principles.

Meaning in forgiveness

Anger, holding a grudge and hostility can all lead to anxiety, depression, irritability, disturbed sleep, high blood pressure, irregular heart rhythm and a higher risk of heart attack.

Forgiveness, on the other hand, has many benefits. By forgiving, you enjoy improved health, save energy, have better relationships and set an example for others, particularly children.



Science Agrees with the Bible

Here are just some of the benefits of forgiveness.

Forgiveness can enhance physical health. It can improve blood pressure, lower heart rate and improve immunity.

Forgiveness can improve mental and emotional health by promoting better sleep and lowering anxiety, depression and stress levels.

Forgiveness can improve relationships.

Forgiveness can help save your energy.

Forgiveness can help you focus better.

Forgiveness can help you feel good about yourself.

Forgiveness can make you happier.

Applying Forgiveness

Forgiveness doesn't come naturally to the human mind. Forgiveness isn't easy. Forgiveness is as intentional as exercising. Because planning revenge activates the brain's pleasure centers, you'll have to make a considerable effort to forgive. To forgive, you must:

Find the person forgivable

Become a more effective forgiver

Find meaning in forgiveness

Forgiveness is the ultimate test of your ability to embody higher principles. The hurt of unforgiveness originates from failure in gratitude, compassion, acceptance and higher meaning. The more effectively you can practice the other four principles, the easier it will be for you to forgive.

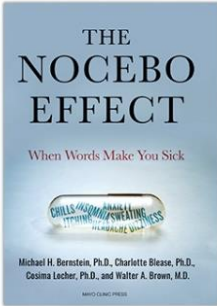

The Nocebo Effect: When Words Make You Sick An investigation of the nocebo effect—the placebo effect's evil twin.



Can beliefs make you sick? Consider "The June Bug" incident from a US textile factory in the early 1960s. Many employees began to feel dizzy, had an upset stomach, and vomited. Some were even hospitalized. The illness was attributed to a mysterious bug biting workers. However, when the CDC investigated this outbreak, no bugs or any other cause of the illnesses could be identified. Instead, it appears to be an illness caused by the mind — that is, sickness due to expectation.

The June Bug story is one of many striking examples of the nocebo effect, a phenomenon best summarized as the occurrence of a harmful event that stems from expecting it. The nocebo effect plays a role in side effects for some of the most commonly prescribed medications. It provides a lens for understanding how sensationalized media reports that sound alarm about public health might even become a self-fulfilling prophecy. It might even explain the mysterious symptoms associated with Havana Syndrome, during which dozens of US government employees fell ill after reportedly being exposed to an unidentified sound wave in Cuba.

We are just discovering the power behind this effect, and how it can be ethically mitigated.

Example of Baptism

³ Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? ⁴ Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. ⁵ For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be ¹*in the likeness* of His resurrection, ⁶ knowing this, that our old self was crucified with *Him*, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; ⁷ for he who has died is freed from sin. ⁸ Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, - ***Romans 6:3-8***

Example of Slavery

⁹ knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, is never to die again; death no longer is master over Him. - ***Romans 6:9***

¹⁴ For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace. ¹⁵ What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? May it never be! ¹⁶ Do you not know that when you present yourselves to someone *as* slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience resulting in righteousness? - ***Romans 6:14-16***

¹⁷ But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you became obedient from the heart to that form of teaching to which you were committed, ¹⁸ and having been freed from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. ¹⁹ I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness, resulting in *further* lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness, resulting in sanctification. ²⁰ For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. ²¹ Therefore what benefit were you then deriving from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the outcome of those things is death. ²² But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life. ²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. - ***Romans 6:17-23***
