John 11:1 – *Now a certain man was sick, Lazarus of Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha.*

John 11:2 – *And it was the Mary who anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped His feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.*

- Mary anoints Jesus in _____

John 11:3 – *The sisters therefore sent to Him, saying, “Lord, behold, he whom You love is sick.”*

- Greek *Phileo* - _____ love

John 11:4 – *But when Jesus heard it, He said, “This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified by it.”*

John 8:54 – *Jesus answered, “If I glorify Myself, My glory is nothing; it is My Father who glorifies Me, of whom you say, ‘He is our God’;*

- Isaiah 42:8 – *“I am the Lord, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, Nor My praise to graven images.*
- Isaiah 48:11 – *“For My own sake, for My own sake. I will act; For how can My name be profaned? And My glory I will not give to another.*

WE GLORIFY THE FATHER AND THE SON WHEN WE BELIEVE

Two Ways the Son receives glory from the sickness

1. Immediate - Raising of Lazarus from the dead

- a. John 11:45 – *Many therefore of the Jews, who had come to Mary and beheld what He had done, believed in Him.*
- b. The Son receives glory when we _____

2. Crucifixion/Resurrection

- a. John 11:57 – *Now the chief priests and the Pharisees had given orders that if anyone knew where He was, he should report it, that they might seize Him.*
- b. John 13:31 – *When therefore he had gone out, Jesus said, “Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in Him; (32) if God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him immediately.*

Lazarus has to die to be the perfect picture of the of the son

John 11:4 – *But when Jesus heard it, He said, “This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified by it.”*
