How has God used a proper, righteous or holy action intended for the glory of God, far beyond what you intended?

John 12:1 – *Jesus, therefore, six days before the Passover, came to Bethany where Lazarus was, whom Jesus had raised from the dead.*

John 12:2 – *So they made Him a supper there, and Martha was serving; but Lazarus was one of those reclining at the table with Him.*

John 12:3 – *Mary therefore took a pound of very costly perfume of pure nard, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped His feet with her hair; and the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume.*

John 12:4 – *But Judas Iscariot, one of His disciples, who was intending to betray Him, said,*

- Matthew 26:8 – *But the disciples were indignant when they saw this, and said, “Why this waste?”*
- Matthew 26:9 – *“For this perfume might have been sold for a high price and the money given to the poor.”*

John 12:5 – *“Why was this perfume not sold for three hundred denarii, and given to poor people?”*

John 12:6 – *Now he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief, and as he had the money box, he used to pilfer what was put into it.*

John 12:7 – *Jesus therefore said, “Let her alone, in order that she may keep it for the day of My burial.*

- ESV/NASB - Therefore Jesus said, “let her alone, so that she may keep it for the day of My burial”
 - Mark 14:3 – *And while He was in Bethany at the home of Simon the leper, and reclining at the table, there came a woman with an alabaster vial of very costly perfume of pure nard; and she broke the vial and poured it over His head.*
- **NIV - “Leave her alone,” Jesus replied. “It was intended that she should save this perfume for the day of my burial.”**
- NLT - “Leave her alone. She did this in preparation for my burial.”
- KJV - Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.
- **NKJV - “Let her alone; she has kept this for the day of My burial.**

John 12:8 – *“For the poor you always have with you, but you do not always have me.”*

The anointing of the Passover lamb

Exodus 12:1 – *Now the Lord said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt. (2) “This month shall be the beginning of months for you; it is to be the first month of the year to you. (3) “Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, ‘On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers’ households, a lamb for each household. (4) ‘No if the household is too small for a lamb, then he and his neighbor nearest to his house are to take one according to the number of persons in them; according to what each man should eat, you are to divide the lamb.*

(5) Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats. (6) And you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month, then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight.

Exodus 12:12 – *‘For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike down all the first-born in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments- I am the Lord. (13) ‘And the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.*

John 1:29 – *The next day he saw Jesus coming to him, and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”*

Isaiah 53:7 – *He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, so He did not open His mouth.*

I Corinthians 5:6 – *Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough? (7) Clean out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed. (8) Let us therefore celebrate the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.*
