John 13:36 – *Simon Peter said to Him, “Lord where are You going?” Jesus answered, “Where I go, you cannot follow Me now; but you will follow later.”*

- John 13:33 – *“Little children, I am with you a little while longer. You will seek Me; and as I said to the Jews, now I also say to you, ‘Where I am going, you cannot come.’*
- “You will follow afterward” - a new _____
 - Jesus knows Peter will follow Him to _____

John 13:37 – *Peter said to Him, “Lord, why can I not follow You right now? I will lay down my life for You.”*

John 13:38 – *Jesus answered, “Will you lay down your life for Me? Truly, truly, I say to you, a rooster will not crow, until you deny Me three times.*

- Peter’s initial life answer to Jesus’ question = _____
 - John 18:15 – *Simon Peter was following Jesus, and so was another disciple. Now that disciple was known to the high priest, and entered with Jesus into the court of the high priest.*
 - John 18:16 – *but Peter was standing at the door outside. So the other disciple, who was known to the high priest, went out and spoke to the doorkeeper, and brought Peter in.*
 - John 16:17 – *Then the slave-girl who kept the door said to Peter, “You are not also one of this man’s disciples, are you?” He said, “I am not.”*

- John 16:18 – *Now the slaves and the officers were standing there, having made a charcoal fire, for it was cold and they were warming themselves; and Peter was also with them, standing and warming himself.*
- John 18:25 – *Now Simon Peter was standing and warming himself. So they said therefore to him, “You are not also one of His disciples, are you?” He denied it, and said, “I am not.”*
- John 18:26 – *One of the slaves of the high priest, being a relative of the one whose ear Peter cut off, said, “Did I not see you in the garden with Him?”*
- John 18:27 – *Peter then denied it again; and immediately a rooster crowed.*
- Peter's eventual life answer to Jesus' question = _____
 - John 21:15 – *So when they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these?” He said to Him, “Yes, Lord; You know that I love you.” He said to him, “Tend My lambs.”*
 - John 21:16 – *He said to him again a second time, “Simon, son of John, do you love Me?” He said to Him, “Yes, Lord; You know that I love You.” He said to him, “Shepherd My sheep.”*
 - John 21:17 – *He said to him the third time, “Simon, son of John, do you love Me?” Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, “Do you love Me?” And he said to Him, “Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You.” Jesus said to him, “Tend My Sheep.”*

- John 21:18 – *“Truly, truly, I say to you, when you were younger, you used to gird yourself, and walk wherever you wished; but when you grow old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will gird you, and bring you where you do not wish to go.”*
- John 21:19 – *Now this He said, signifying by what kind of death he would glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, “Follow Me!”*
