John 14:18 - "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. (19) Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. (20) In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. (21) Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him." (22) Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, "Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?" (23) Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. <u>I Will Be In You</u>

#1 – John 14:20 - **You will know that I am in My Father, and you in** *Me, and I in you:* Through the Holy Spirit they would know a life of a continued relationship, shared life, and union with God the Father, God the Son, and in the disciple.

- This union is evidenced by knowledge of God's will (has My commandments)
- This union is evidenced by obedience to God's will (and keeps them)
- This union is evidenced by love (is he who loves me)
- This union is marked by relationship and reception of love with God the Father (**will be loved by My Father**)
- This union is evidenced by a revelation of Jesus Himself (and manifest Myself to him)

All this flows from the union with God in the disciple through

#2 – John 14:21 - He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me:

Here are two commandments Jesus gave to His disciples earlier in John:

Command #1 – John 13:14 – "If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. (15) For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you."

Command # 2 – John 13:34 – "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. (35) By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."
