John 17:2 – even as You gave Him authority over all flesh, that to all whom You have given Him, He may give eternal life.

Parallels

Glorify your son" = "you have given Him authority"

 \_\_\_\_\_\_ - "that the son may glorify you" = "to all whom you have given Him, He may give eternal life"

John 17:3 – "This is eternal life, that they may know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
