“Judas Betrays Jesus

John 18:1 - When Jesus had spoken these words, He went away with His disciples across the ravine of the Kidron, where there was a garden which He entered with His disciples.

John 18:2 - Now Judas, who was betraying Him, also knew the place, because Jesus had often met there with His disciples.

John 18:3 - So Judas, having obtained the Roman cohort and officers from the chief priests and the Pharisees, came there with lanterns, torches, and weapons.

John 18:4 - Jesus therefore, knowing all the things that were coming upon Him, came out into the open and said to them, “Whom are you seeking?”

John 18:5 - They answered Him, "Jesus the Nazarene." He said to them, "I am He." And Judas also, who was betraying Him, was standing with them.

John 18:6 - Now then, when He said to them, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground.

John 18:7 - He then asked them again, "Whom are you seeking?" And they said, "Jesus the Nazarene."

John 18:8 - Jesus answered, "I told you that I am He; so if you are seeking Me, let these men go on their way."

John 18:9 - This took place so that the word which He spoke would be fulfilled: "Of those whom You have given Me I lost not one."

John 18:10 - Then Simon Peter, since he had a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's slave, and cut off his right ear; and the slave's name was Malchus.

John 18:11 - So Jesus said to Peter, "Put the sword into the sheath; the cup which the Father has given Me, am I not to drink it?"

John 18:12 - So the Roman cohort, the commander, and the officers of the Jews arrested Jesus and bound Him,
