



are lower on the career ladder than we are. He tells us to pull them up with us. "Love him as yourself, for you were aliens in Egypt. I am the Lord your God" (Leviticus 19:3-4). In a few words God both levels and lifts us: "You were an alien, too," and "I am your Lord God."
