John 19:1 – Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged Him.

John 19:2 – And the soldiers wove a crown of thorns and put it on His head, and arrayed Him in a purple robe;

John 19:3 – and they began to come up to Him, and say, "Hail, King of the Jews!" and to give Him blows in the face.

John 19:4 – And Pilate came out again, and said to them, "Behold, I am bringing Him out to you, that you may know that I find no guilt in Him."

John 19:5 – Jesus therefore came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. And Pilate said to them, "Behold, the Man!"

John 19:6 – When therefore the chief priests and the officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, "Crucify, crucify!" Pilate said to them, "Take Him yourselves and crucify Him, for I find no guilt in Him."

John 19:7 – The Jews answered him, "We have a law, and by that law He ought to die because He made himself out to be the Son of God."

John 19:8 – When Pilate therefore heard this statement, he was the more afraid;

John 19:9 – and he entered into the Praetorium again, and said to Jesus. "Where are You from?" But Jesus gave him no answer.

John 19:10 – Pilate therefore said to Him, "You do not speak to me? Do You not know that I have authority to release You, and I have authority to crucify You?"

John 19:11 – Jesus answered, "You would have no authority over Me, unless it had been given you from above; for this reason he who delivered Me up to you has the greater sin."

John 19:12 – As a result of this Pilate made efforts to release Him, but the Jews cried out, saying, "If you release this Man, you are no friend of Caesar; everyone who makes himself out to be a king opposes Caesar."

John 19:13 – When Pilate therefore heard these words, he brought Jesus out, and sat down on the judgment seat at a place called The Pavement, but in Hebrew, Gabbatha.

John 19:14 – Now it was the day of preparation for the Passover; it was about the sixth hour. And he said to the Jews, "Behold, your King!"

John 19:15 – They therefore cried out, "Away with Him, away with Him, crucify Him" Pilate said to them, "Shall I crucify your King?" The chief priests answered, "We have not king but Caesar."

John 19:16 – So he then delivered Him to them to be crucified.

John 19:17 – They took Jesus therefore, and He went out, bearing His own cross, to the place called the Place of the Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha.

John 19:18 – There they crucified Him, and with Him two other men, one on either side, and Jesus in between.

John 19:19 – And Pilate wrote an inscription also, and put it on the cross. And it was written, "JESUS THE NAZARENE, THE KING OF THE JEWS."

John 19:20 – Therefore this inscription many of the Jews read, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city; and it was written in Hebrew, Latin and in Greek.

John 19:21 – And so the chief priests of the Jews were saying to Pilate, "Do not write, 'The King of the Jews;' but that He said, 'I am King of the Jews.'"

John 19:22 - Pilate answered, "What I have written I have written."
