



Reflect today on the commitments you have made to others that need your action this week.





John 21:1 – After these things Jesus manifested Himself again to the disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, and He manifested Himself in this way.

John 21:2 – Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two others of His disciples were together.

John 21:3 – Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We will also come with you." They went out and got into the boat; and that night they caught nothing.

- Mark 14:28 "But after I have been raised, I will go ahead of you to Galilee."
- Mark 16:7 "But go, tell His disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see Him, just as He told you,"

John 21:4 – But when the day was now breaking, Jesus stood on the beach; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus.

John 21:5 – So Jesus said to them, "Children, you do not have any fish, do you?" They answered Him, "No."

John 21:6 – And He said to them, "Cast the net on the right-hand side of the boat and you will find a catch." So they cast, and then they were not able to haul it in because of the great number of fish.

John 21:7 – Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord." So when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put his outer garment on (for he was stripped for work), and threw himself into the sea.

 Luke 5:1 – Now it happened that while the crowd was pressing around Him and listening to the word of God, He was standing by the lake of Gennesaret:

- Luke 5:2 and He saw two boats lying at the edge of the lake; but the fishermen had gotten out of them and were washing their nets.
- Luke 5:3 And He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little way from the land. And He sat down and began teaching the people from the boat.
- Luke 5:4 When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch."
- Luke 5:5 Simon answered and said, "Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing, but I will do as You say and let down the nets."
- Luke 5:6 When they had done this, they enclosed a great quantity of fish, and their nets began to break;
- Luke 5:7 so they signaled to their partners in the other boat for them to come and help them. And they came and filled both of the boats, so that they began to sink.
- Luke 5:8 But when Simon Peter saw that, he fell down at Jesus' feet, saying, "Go away from me Lord, for I am a sinful man!"
- Luke 5:9 For amazement had seized him and all his companions because of the catch of fish which they had taken.
- Luke 5:10 and so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not fear, from now on you will be catching men."
- Luke 5:11 When they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed Him.

John 21:8 – But the other disciples came in the little boat, for they were not far from the land, but about one hundred yards away, dragging the net full of fish.

• Don't discount different people's ______ to Jesus John 21:9 – So when they got out on the land, they saw a charcoal fire already laid and fish placed on it, and bread.

John 21:10 – Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish which you have now caught."

John 21:11 – Simon Peter went up and drew the net to land, full of large fish, a hundred and fifty-three; and although there were so many, the net was not torn.

- Without Jesus they had ______ to bring to God

John 21:12 – Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast." None of the disciples ventured to question Him. "Who are You?" knowing that it was the Lord.

John 21:13 – Jesus came and took the bread and gave it to them, and the fish likewise.

John 21:14 – This is not the third time that Jesus was manifested to the disciples, after He was raised from the dead.
