Candle Two Equals Bethlehem (Second Week of Advent) Micah 5:2 and John 6:35

The second candle represents faith and is called "Bethlehem's Candle." Micah had foretold that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem, which is also the birthplace of King David. This candle reminds of the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem

The old, beautiful city of Bethlehem is surrounded by barren, unproductive regions – the wilderness of the Sinai and the mountains of Moab. Bethlehem means "the house of bread." God chose this insignificant village as the birthplace of His Son.

Bread has long been a staple food for the human race. Leavened and unleavened, it is mentioned many times in Scripture. When the Israelite slaves had to free Egypt, they ate unleavened bread that they could prepare quickly. Curing their wandering in the desert on the way to the Promised Land, God showered heavenly bread on their encampments: manna. During His final Passover supper with the disciples, Jesus used bread as an illustration of Himself. He said that He was "the Bread of Life." What does this mean to us? Even as bread sustains physical life, Jesus can bring us life, strength and satisfaction when we have faith in Him.

Bethlehem – the house of bread; Jesus – the Bread of Life. Use this day to focus on the only One who can satisfy the hunger of your soul.
