



- 1. Recently our church gave \$5,000.00 to help the suffering people in Ukraine with special personal delivery by our Missionary, Steve Evers.
- In the last week \$8,379,25 was sent to A Perfect Injustice to help orphans in Uganda through Abigail and David Kakeeto, the daughter of one of our former pastors Steve Tracy. Thanks to all donors!
