3. Today we received this request from a wife who does not attend our church. "Please pray for the salvation of my husband Eric. May God soften his heart to have a deep love and personal relationship with Jesus. May he be delivered from any bitterness and darkness. Pray that he will give his life to Christ."

4. A couple weeks ago a ten-year-old boy was at the beach, swimming in the ocean and drowned. Several people tried CPR but the boy did not respond. Pray for the family. Pray for the other children who were swimming with this boy.

5. Last Sunday was his first time in our church. He said, "I am looking for a church community but I have 'lost my faith' and I want to find it again. I was raised in a church, but didn't really understand spirituality. I would definitely be in hell if I died today. I work full-time but my family lives in California. Pray for me. Seeking acceptance from local police academy for a career in law enforcement." I said, "Keep seeking God. Come to worship often. How can I help? Keep pursuing God, don't stop."

6. God is always working good in you. Agee? Disagree? God only leads you by His great good reasons for your benefit through every good and bad and ugly testing or challenge. Right? Our good God is working in you and everyone else. Right? Unjustified and ungodly anger is never from God.



Right? The best vengeance, correction comes from God not you. Right?

Increased patience plus increased faith equals humble strong contentment in the ways and plans of God. Right? When we feel discouraged and frustrated we must ask if we need to trust God MORE. Right? When joy is low in us it is reasonable to say our faith in God is low. Right? When faith in God explodes, joy and patience also go up. Right? God only has great good plans for you even when you CANNOT see His plans. God is always working good in you. Agee? Disagree?

7. "Recently a portion of my backyard fence went down in a wind storm," said a church member. "My fence spans the backyards of two neighbors and the downed portion only effected one neighbor. I submitted a claim to the insurance company as did my neighbor and I received a settlement that was lower than expected to replace the fence. So, I submitted more information to the insurance company and got a settlement that more than doubled. I could now consider replacing the rest of the fence that did not come down with my other neighbor if they would agree to share the cost. The second neighbor agreed. So, after insurance we paid \$755.00 (my deductible was \$500) to replace 97' of an ugly old 5' 5" high cement panel fence with a brand new 6' high block fence."

8. I thank God and I deeply appreciate Christians like Wayne Shedenhelm, Joy Getz, Pam Rosendale, Spike Nicholson, Paul and Sharon Turck, John and Carol Becker and many others who often reach out to people who are struggling in one way or another, are isolated



and restricted at home or are in a care center or hospital due to a wide range of health issues. These people send cards, pray, offer support, visit and make phone calls to encourage the weak, discouraged and challenged.

9. Early in August she shared she just turned 71 years old and recently retired. As a child she grew up in a mountain village in Korea, in Buddhism. She said, "I remember walking as a child on Christmas Eve and heard people in a church singing. I entered the church and they gave me a candy cane. For the first time I heard the story of the birth of Jesus and I began to believe in Jesus Christ as my Savior and I began to follow Jesus. With a glowing smile, Jesus has always taken good care of me since I was a child."

10. One hundred orphans in Uganda recently received \$9,000.00 from FBCT to build classroom #7 at their school. They already have six classrooms finished but they needed to construct their seventh and final classroom to be able to have a primary school which has seven grades. Any funds left over after construction of

this classroom will go for buying desks, bookshelves and textbooks for the students that would be using the classroom. Praise God for much mercy at FBCT.

11. One person writes, "I am asking you to pray for Stephanie. Stephanie used to work in strip clubs. She no longer works in these clubs, but she still entertains men, does drugs and takes part in unhealthy relationships." Please pray for Stephanie, please intercede for Stephanie. Pray that God will place people in her life to bring the healing love of God's heart. God bless you.

12. My son needs prayer. "My son is homeless. He does have a job but his apartment complex raised the rent to a point he cannot afford. He lives in Flagstaff and with the students returning to classes now, most of the housing has been taken." Let's pray for this son.

13. Don't ask for help. "I was listening online to the sermon since I wasn't able to make it to church. I finally realized the true meaning of humility. Humbling myself when I needed help was something I have never done. I grew up learning to deal with my own problems and not to ask for help. I really hurt myself in the long-run by not doing so. It amazes me how, at my age, that I'm still learning valuable biblical truths." Praise God. Practice daily humility.

14. Invaluable. Priceless. She loves and serves Jesus faithfully with excellent research skills. Her problem-solving analytical skills are outstanding. No one needs to give her reminders because she is most proactive. Most important she loves people. We praise God for Bev Martin who serves in many ways throughout the church.

15. Last night at 6:00 pm Sunday night church Harold said, "My brother, 78 years old, and every morning of his life went to the gym and ran marathons almost every year. Extremely healthy. But a couple days ago he died of pancreatic cancer." I said, "I am so sorry." Harold said, "No





one knows how many days we have left to live. You can NOT predict life. We do not have full control." I said, "Every day should be a smile. We should love, encourage and inspire others and don't wait to be loved and inspired.

16. Three positive college students came to church for the first-time last Sunday. Two Asian Christians and one spiritual seeking Hindu non-Christian. I said, "Hi" and introduced myself. They followed with their introductions and a few welcoming comments. The non-believer said he was a data scientist. I said, "Are you an IRS agent?" He laughed and said, "Yes." I asked him, "Are people mean toward you because you work for the IRS." He said, "Yes." I said, "Jesus had friends who were tax collectors. Jesus will not be mean to you. I will do my best not to be mean. Thank you for coming to church and learning about Jesus today."

17. Less than three months ago on their first visit to our church a couple attended the 8:00 am Worship Service. I said, "Hello" and welcomed them. They came back a few times to the 8:00 am and then I saw them in the 9:30 am Worship Service and a couple Sundays ago she sang in the choir. Yesterday she sang in the choir again and her husband played in the orchestra with that big violin called the base violin. Thank you to both of you for serving Jesus with the gifts God has given you.

18. A lady said to me, "What should I do with my pre-teen daughter about her gender. My family has bullied me most of my life. I do not want to bully my daughter. I don't want to tell her what gender she should be." I said to this mom, "Be your daughter's mother and guide her the way Jesus would guide her, gently and firmly guide her.
