





1. Why? Big push to remove and censor God. Why? Because when God is silenced you eliminate the facts described in the Bible. Right and wrong stated in the Bible becomes irrelevant and meaningless. You remove the Ten



Commandments, the gospel of forgiveness by Jesus, heaven and hell. No more boundaries. No laws. No rules. No guidelines. No absolutes. No need for parents to oversee children. No more referees. No judges. No police. No prisoners. No prisons. What would driving your car be like? Would you go for a walk outside in the daytime? Imagine the chaos of a public-school classroom. No need for marriages, families and friends. Everyone becomes a lawless narcissistic god when you remove the God of the Bible from day to day life.

2. Despair. Pray for the young adult who has thoughts of despair. Life guarantees major disappointment and heartbreak to the young and old. Pray. Talk to God. Speak to a trusted friend now. Sooner or later everyone feels the shattering of their heart. Pray for a young adult going through the valley of great sadness. Pray for God's power of Psalm 23 to move this discouraged person from defeat and trauma to hope and victory. I thank God for the many people actively assisting this young adult in the name of Jesus.

"Idolatry and Sexual Sin"

Ezekiel 23:1 - The word of the Lord came to me again, saying,

Ezekiel 23:2 – "Son of man, there were two women, the daughters of one mother;

Ezekiel 23:3 – and they played the harlot in Egypt. They played the harlot in their youth; there their breasts were pressed and there their virgin bosom was handled.

Ezekiel 23:4 – "Their names were Oholah and elder and Oholibah her sister. And they became Mine, and they bore sons and daughters. And as for their names, Samaria is Oholah and Jerusalem is Oholibah.

Ezekiel 23:5 – "Oholah played the harlot while she was Mine; and she lusted after her lovers, after the Assyrians, her neighbors,

Ezekiel 23:6 – who were clothed in purple, governors and officials, all of them desirable young men, horsemen riding on horses.

Ezekiel 23:7 – "She bestowed her harlotries on them, all of whom were the choicest men of Assyria; and with all whom she lusted after, with all their idols she defiled herself.

Ezekiel 23:8 – "She did not forsake her harlotries from the time in Egypt; for in her youth men had lain with her, and they handled her virgin bosom and poured out their lust on her.

Ezekiel 23:9 – "Therefore, I gave her into the hand of her lovers, into the hand of the Assyrians, after whom she lusted.

Ezekiel 23:10 – "They uncovered her nakedness; they took her sons and her daughters, but they slew her with the sword. Thus she became a byword among women, and they executed judgments on her.

Ezekiel 23:11 – "Now her sister Oholibah saw this, yet she was more corrupt in her lust than she, and her harlotries were more than the harlotries of her sister.

Ezekiel 23:12 – "She listed after the Assyrians, governors and officials, the ones near, magnificently dressed, horsemen riding on horses, all of them desirable young men.

Ezekiel 23:13 – "I saw that she had defined herself; they both took the same way.

Ezekiel 23:14 – "So she increased her harlotries. And she saw men portrayed on the wall, images of the Chaldeans portrayed with vermilion,

Ezekiel 23:15 – girded with belts on their loins, with flowing turbans on their heads, all of them looking like officers, like the Babylonians in Chaldea, the land of their birth.

Ezekiel 23:16 – "When she saw the she lusted after them and sent messengers to them in Chaldea.

Ezekiel 23:17 – "The Babylonians came to her to the bed of love and defiled her with their harlotry. And when she had been defiled by them, she became disgusted with them.

Ezekiel 23:18 – "She uncovered her harlotries and uncovered her nakedness; then I became disgusted with her, and I had become disgusted with her sister.

Ezekiel 23:19 – "Yet she multiplied her harlotries, remembering the days of her youth, when she played the harlot in the land of Egypt.

Ezekiel 23:20 – "She lusted after their paramours, whose flesh is like the flesh of donkeys and whose issue is like the issue of horses.

Ezekiel 23:21 – "Thus you longed for the lewdness of your youth, when the Egyptians handled your bosom because of the breasts of your youth.

Ezekiel 23:22 – "Therefore, O Oholibah, thus says the Lord God, 'Behold I will arouse your lovers against you, from whom you were alienated, and I will bring them against you from every side;

Ezekiel 23:23 – the Babylonians and all the Chaldeans, Pikod and Shoa and Koa, and all the Assyrians with them; desirable young men, governors and officials all of them, officers and men or renown, all of them riding on horses.

Ezekiel 23:24 – 'They will come against you with weapons, chariots and wagons, and with a company of peoples. They will set

themselves against you on every side with buckler and shield and helmet; and I will commit the judgment to them, and they will judge you according to their customs.

Ezekiel 23:25 – 'I will set My jealousy against you, and they may deal with you in wrath. They will remove your nose and your ears; and your survivors will fall by the sword. They will take your sons and your daughters; and your survivors will be consumed by the fire.

Ezekiel 23:26 – 'They will also strip you of your clothes and take away your beautiful jewels.

Ezekiel 23:27 – 'Thus I will make your lewdness and your harlotry brought from the land of Egypt to cease from you, so that you will not lift up your eyes to them or remember Egypt anymore.

Ezekiel 23:28 – "For thus says the Lord God, 'Behold, I will give you into the hand of those whom you hate, into the hand of those from whom you were alienated.

Ezekiel 23:29 – 'They will deal with you in hatred, take all your property, and leave you naked and bare. And the nakedness of your harlotries will be uncovered, both your lewdness and your harlotries.

Ezekiel 23:30 – 'These things will be done to you because you have played the harlot with the nations, because you have defiled yourself with their idols.

Ezekiel 23:31 – 'You have walked in the way of your sister; therefore I will give her cup into your hand.'

Ezekiel 23:32 – 'Thus says the Lord God, 'You will drink your sister's cup, Which is deep and wide. You will be laughed at and held in derision; It contains much.

Ezekiel 23:33 – 'You will be filled with drunkenness and sorrow, The cup of horror and desolation, The cup of your sister Samaria.

Ezekiel 23:34 – 'You will drink it and drain it. Then you will gnaw its fragments And tear your breasts; for I have spoken,' declares the Lord God,
