



God Stories Middle of October 2022

9. Special. A child who attended our church many years ago has become a successful published author. The title of her book is Reclaiming YOU. It focuses on moving from trauma to resilience. Many of you loved and mentored her in her teen years and as a young adult. Your acts of patience and truth-telling guided this child to help her become a trauma therapist. Congratulations to Sharon Ball in the launch of her new book.

10. Pray for my sister. “My sister who lives in Alabama has a spot on her lung and is waiting to have a CT scan. Hoping it is just scar tissue which the doctor believes it to be. Also, her son, who has struggled with type 1 diabetes since the age of two, is now having bad chest pains. He has been referred to a cardiologist. Hoping they find a simple cause and nothing serious. His diabetes has caused many health issues.” Please pray.

11. Eric. Pray for the salvation of Eric, a friend and co-worker of one of our church leaders. Can we pray for salvation of someone you know, maybe a friend, co-worker or an enemy? Investigators believe some of the victims purchased what they thought were pills of Percocet, a prescription painkiller, at a park in a residential area of East Hollywood. "We need to get the word out that this stuff is poison," one leader said. "It's dangerous and it's going to kill more people out here on the streets." Avoid the drugs. Follow Jesus to find forgiveness, peace and purpose. Jesus saves. Fentanyl kills.

14. Special wedding bells. We first met her with her parents as a newborn in our church. Many of you encouraged and watched her grow up through her school years. Now as a young adult she is considering pre-marriage counseling with the goal of a wedding honoring to God. Pray for wisdom for this young adult. Pray for this engaged couple as they both seek to honor God and experience pre-marriage counseling. Pray to God to bless this young couple.



15. Act now to say "Thanks" to all police officers and especially our Sunday morning police officers who show much kindness and respect. Say "Thanks" to all first responders who serve tirelessly with excellence. Give appreciation to all military personnel for their sacrifice and devotion to defending and protecting America. Give "Thanks" to all public servants who rush to offer a helping hand to people in need. The kindness and service described above comes from the values of Jesus Christ recorded in the Bible. Praise God for freedom of speech, freedom of religion and freedom to say "Thank you."
