



Praise God. Your donations and offerings each Sunday are deeply appreciated and definitely helpful.
- Families in our church face "monthly painful challenges." Hardship 7. has become a way of life for these families. But all of these families serve God with a smile among us. They work hard. They purpose to pay their bills on time. Lazy, no. No scams here. But no savings. Some families are younger. Some are older. Red, yellow, black and white and they all need some help during the holidays. Some families struggle every month to make medical payments on major medical expenses. Some families work part-time as they constantly look for full-time employment. From big families to families of one. Some face the loss of their rental home and some contemplate being homeless. Some live paycheck to paycheck on part-time wages. Some walk or ride the bus. Some families have one car. Some have no insurance. We would like to help 20 low income families in our church with some extra money at Thanksgiving or Christmas. For all non-sin issues share your anger issues with a trusted friend. Seek accountability. Promise yourself and God to avoid using anger because it rarely helps anyone.

- 9. Disappointed? Frustrated? Discouraged?
  When life and the people around you are childish do
  this: Press on for Jesus. Keep your eyes and emotions
  focused on Jesus. Forgive as Jesus would. Keep listening well and pointing
  people to Jesus. Keep being inspired to be Jesus to them. Keep loving the
  people as Jesus would. Keep building a team who follow Jesus. Keep being a
  sacrificial leader of Jesus. Pray. Pray. All for Jesus.
- 10. "Unrealistic expectations," he said. "Fear got hold of me," he said. So, I responded to him, "God is truly at work in and around you. Trust God with joy to do His part. Celebrate. Smile constantly. Your job and my job are to inspire the young to follow Jesus and forgive and forget the past mistakes on the old. Always be an outstanding Barnabas. God will always be our miracle God and do the impossible in the darkest situations. Lead like Barnabas. Teach like Paul. Forgive like Peter. Have the faith of David. Be an amazing servant like Mary."
- 11. Can you spot God at work? "A couple weeks ago I joined a group of FBC sisters at Prescott Pines for and excellent Women's Retreat with 300 other women. As I was leaving for retreat I dropped a text to our high school friend, Jim Allen, to say Happy 80th Birthday and mentioned I was off to retreat and said my first time at Prescott Pines was 64 years ago for youth camp. Jim and Trish Allen, missionaries our church supported the whole 30+ years they served in Quito, Ecuador with Reach Beyond formally called HCJB World Radio are now retired," says Joy Morse. Jim Allen replied to Joy by saying, "Enjoy Prescott Pines. LOTS of memories there. I think my mom was camp nurse there in the early 50's and I went to a Men's Retreat with my dad, probably 71 or 72 years ago. I dedicated my life to Christ for missionary service there in 1955. Then I directed Senior High School Camp for a couple summers in the late 60's." Life is truly connected by God.
- 12. Broken. Broken. Why not forgive? What about Jesus? I know two stubborn childish Christians who will not speak to each other because of small differences. We have two titanic choices when we fail each other. We can truly forgive so we can move toward each other like Jesus

Jesus offers mercy, self-sacrifice and forgiveness but Satan pushes arrogance, bitterness and slander. What kind of Christians will be in Heaven? The forgiven kind. Thank God that Jesus forgives us. Follow Jesus. Forgive your enemies. Avoid foolishness. Forgive your Christian brothers and sisters.
