



Even so, they exist to do the will of God and consistently reject any worship or praise directed toward themselves, always insisting that worship is for God alone.

Angels have directly involved themselves in the affairs of humanity wince the creation of Adam and Eve. Sometimes they have prevented courses of action, and many times they have encouraged, strengthened and helped people physically. 
