“Hope”

Hope is a fundamental component of the life of the righteous (Proverbs 23:18). Without hope, life loses its meaning (Lamentations 3:18; Job 7:6) and in death there is no hope (Isaiah 38:18; Job 17:15). The righteous who put their hope in God will be assisted (Psalm 28:7), and they will not be defeated, put to shame, or disappointed (Isaiah 49:23). The righteous, who have his or her trustful hope in God, have a general confidence in God’s protection and help (Jeremiah 29:11) and are free from fear and anxiety (Psalm 46:2-3) - (Source: *What is the Christian’s Hope?* www.GotQuestions.org)

1. Hope is Heartfelt Prayers

- a. I Samuel 1:13 - *“Hannah was praying in her heart and her lips were moving but her voice was not heard.”*

2. Hope is Trusting in God’s Power and Ability to Answer

- b. I Samuel 1:18 - *“Then she went her way and ate something, and her face was no longer downcast.”*

3. Hope is Sacrificing to God our Most Treasured

- a. *I Samuel 1:11 - "And she made a vow saying 'Lord Almighty, if you will only look on your servant's misery and remember me and not forget your servant but give her a son, then I will give him to the Lord for all the days of his life and no razor will ever be used on his head.'"*

4. Hope is Being Faithful to God

- a. *I Samuel 1:26 - "As surely as you live, my lord, I am the woman who stood here beside you praying to the Lord."*
- b. *I Samuel 1:27 - I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of him.*
- c. *I Samuel 1:28 - So now I give him to the Lord. For his whole life he will be given over to the Lord."*

5. Hope is Praising God and Delighting in His Amazing Work

- a. *I Samuel 2:1 - "Then Hannah prayed and said; 'My heart rejoices in the Lord; in the Lord my horn is lifted high. My mouth boasts over my enemies, for I delight in your deliverance."*

b. *1 Samuel 2:2 - There is no one holy like the Lord; there is no one besides you, there is no Rock like our God.*”
