



June 2026 Debt/Bank Loan for Worship Center, Music Center and Kid City



Originally the Loan was \$1,829,853.44 in November 2016 The Loan is now \$503,281.84 as of July 31, 2023.

FBC Endowment, a support organization of First Baptist Church of Tempe, services the National Bank of Arizona loan out of \$13,500.00 monthly payment from the church. With an additional \$24,000.00 of contributions each year, that loan would be fully paid off in May 2026. (And by the end of that year, a secondary loan of \$110,000.00 would also be paid off.)

Payments of \$13,500 per month (\$162,000.00) can then be used to support other ministries of the church!

Praise God! FBC Expenses, Donations and Budgets

1. Pray for the planning of our 2024 Church Budget.

With our current donation shortfall unless donations significantly go up we likely will reduce the budget by around \$200,000 which would include a reduction of ministry dollars and a reduction in staff salaries.

- 2. **Praise God** our donations so far this year are higher than our expenses by \$9,756.00. Our year-to-date General Fund donations are \$758,526.00 and our year-to-date expenses are \$748,770.00. Thank you!!!!!!
- 3. **Every donation dollar is appreciated and protected**. We receive many positive comments about the ministries of FBCT.
- 4. **Every donation dollar goes to meet the basic needs of FBC** not extravagant wants.
- 5. We never deficit spend We keep our expenses in line with our donations.
- 6. Our **budgeted missionaries are being paid 100 percent** of their budgeted amount. Our **Faith Promise missionaries are being paid at 80 percent** of our Faith Promise amount due to decreased donations.
- 7. *Our 2023 donations are below the 2023 budget by 20 percent* or \$185,518.00. Our year-to-date budget is \$944,044.00 and our year-to-date donations are \$758,526.00.
- 8. *Pray for wisdom in planning the 2024 Proposed Budget and Faith Promise giving*. We are not able to hire new staff members out of the budget unless donations increase. We will continue budgeting four full-time pastors, one full-time administrative staff member, a hand full of part-time staff members and welcome and celebrate a host of volunteers.
- 9. Pray as we continue to reduce the bank debt on our building through the Support Organization, FBC Endowment. It is possible to pay off the bank debt in June 2026 through budgeted funds and extra annual giving of \$24,000.00. Thank you for making extra donations for debt reduction to FBC Tempe Legacy.
- 10. *Pray for donations to exceed our budget* in order to continue advancing the gospel of Jesus Chris

2023 August God Stories

- 1. Our Guadalupe Church Plant. A couple weeks ago Pastor Peter and Trisha assisted one of the individuals that attends our gatherings (prayer gatherings from the summer) and church plant activities and events. She is a single mom of three. We were able to assist her family with nearly a month's worth of groceries. When our son was speaking to one of the children, the child had mentioned that they hadn't eaten anything that day. God calls us to be compassionate in moments like these. Without hesitation my wife and I knew "we gotta help." We prayed for the family, and the family is doing better now.
- 2. I'm mad, frustrated and someone must stop the slandering and lying. I replied to this person, "I join in your frustration. Be patience. Everyone fully trusts you. No one trusts that person. God is actively removing him. Did you think a few months ago God would take this person out? Everyone highly values you. Everything he says makes him look worse in the eyes of everyone. Stay humble. Only speak the truth in kindness. Justice and correction are occurring on this person by God.
- 3. Wow. Big turn-out for new Truth Class. Thank you, teacher Lee Henkleman for creating and teaching the new class on Stop Negative Thinking. Lee writes, "I had thought about teaching a class on how to change negative thinking for about two years but the time never seemed right. The Holy Spirit nudged me hard this past spring so I mentioned the idea to Dianna and she talked to Roger. Well, the time was right! A class agenda was formed, room located and we were off. The class started Sunday, July 9, with 12 people formally registered but class count that first week was 24! The response has been terrific, and new attendees came the second week. I am grateful to God for leading me to offer the knowledge I have to people who have responded."
- 4. Laura said, "I can't thank all of you enough. I started going to this church thanks to a neighbor! You wonder how the Lord works? I had not gone to church in years! I said where? I told her I never looked forward to church every Sunday as I feel with this church. As a kid my brother and I would be quiet on Sundays so my parents would over sleep and we would miss Mass! I can't thank you all enough for making me feel welcomed and realize no matter what my week entails I have Sunday to look forward to! Thank you so so much!"
- 5. "Help me," he said. "How do I know if God is 'prompting me' to do something? Should I listening and go with my gut as the saying goes?" I responded with, "The Bible says take every thought captive. (II Corinthians

10:5 and Colossians 2:8). This means evaluate every thought BEFORE you follow it. Mystical feelings may or may not be from the Holy Spirit. Mystical feelings are often ideas which randomly pop into the mind. Always evaluate gut feelings by the holiness of biblical truth. You can listen to your gut (random thoughts and ideas) but they must fully agree with the intel from the Bible. Use intel from the Bible before you go with a 'prompting'. Much wiser to evaluate all mystical feelings by the Bible. The Holy Spirit would never ask you to disobey the Bible. Sometimes mystical feelings are irrational, sinful and not from God."

- 6. From a grateful FBC friend. She said, "We are blessed to have servant-leaders as Pastors at FBC. A last-minute need arose. It was not a big task but one that needed to be accomplished shortly. After several attempts to find help I called Julie in the FBC church office for suggested youth names I might call. Within 15 minutes Pastor Rob and Pastor Anthony showed up!! Task accomplished very quickly and they were on their way back to the church. What a heart-warming experience that two busy young Pastors would stop "just like that" to meet an immediate need. Thank you, Pastor Rob and Pastor Anthony."
- 7. The Bible says angels in camouflage can show up in our lives. On an extremely hot July Sunday morning around 7:45 am Ryan said to me, "I'm homeless and I have been walking for a couple hours. Can I sit in the church lobby?" I said, "Yes and would you like a cold coke?" Ryan's eyes and voice said "YES." I took Ryan to the cafe and we gave him a cold Pepsi and bottle of water. Ryan stayed for the 8:00 am Worship Service and graciously told me thank you. I don't know if Ryan was an angel but I do know our church treated Ryan with much respect. Never forget Hebrews 13:2 which says, "Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares".
- **8. Praise God, 13 men are headed to Alaska** on August 21, for a fishing trip of a lifetime. Men from FBC, friends, family, and one excited stranger (who won't be a stranger by the end of the trip), will meet from four different states and travel together to see God's beautiful creation. Pray these men grow closer to God and closer to each other.
- **9. Pray and trust God to provide a way.** Women's Ministry Director Kris Williamson writes, "Women's Ministry faced not having a retreat this year because all the camps were full. I prayed God would open the way for us. Six days after praying, a camp facility called. Five cabins were available for September 15-17. Forty-two women joyfully signed up for camp, "Where Friends Gather." The women have met together to sign-up for all

the retreat teams. Standing together at camp worshiping, praying and learning about Jesus builds stronger relationships.

I recognized him to be my childhood friend. We briefly caught up and asked about our families. Lee had a rough life and he was very thankful and grateful for the "work we are doing for the kids" is what he said sincerely. It was amazing to see what God is doing generationally, that it would be his children that we would be pouring into.
- 11. Thank you to our helpful Skylight Café workers. (More help is still needed.) Our point leaders Paulina Harner and Joy Getz create sweet refreshments and sweet hospitality each Sunday morning in our church cafe. Thank you, Aly Lemons, Josiah Lemons (teen), Gloria Webber, Georgina and Scott Neely, Sarvia Ortiz, Cynthia and Ken Enfinger, Fay Bachman, Jerry Paquette, Doris Wood, Chase Reynolds, Melissa Smith, Ken and Rebecca Sandoval, Emma Malmin (teen), David Woodley, Jennifer Williams, Linda Savage, Carolyn Cooper, Ceclia Hughes, Ian Jeffer, Sandra Lesnick, Stuart Lange, Suzy Glendy, Tom Verburg, Grant Getz and Rebecca Getz for volunteering in this ministry.
- 12. Pray for me they asked. They said, "We just spoke the truth in love to our adult child who hatefully rejects the morality advanced by Jesus in the Bible. It is hard to watch your adult children rebel against God." I replied, "My heart breaks for all of you. I fully believe God and the Bible supports you. Keep following the Bible. Love in the Bible includes saying No".
- 13. Celebrate. Let's thank God for our many volunteers who joyfully serve God several hours EVERY week in our church. - 14. God uses the little things like kindness. You never know how God is using your kindness to minister to others. Recently, I received a card from a friend. It said, "I want to say a big Thank You to you. Your support and friendship over the many years has been such an encouragement. Women's Camp, Bible studies, coffees, chats, prayers and si friendship have

made a lovely difference in my life. Thank you, my friend!" So be kind and see how God blesses those around you.

- **15. Jesus constantly seeks out new friends.** Thank you for welcoming strangers to our church. Recently a young couple visited our church on Sunday night. The husband writes, "My wife and I just recently tried your church out on your Sunday night service at 6:00 pm and we both loved it. We are looking forward to getting connected and involved."
- 16. Goliath was once a baby. Jim Denison, PhD, says, "Goliath in the Bible was once a baby. Then, of course, over time he grew up to become a giant. Sometimes, our 'giants' start out pretty small. You might be dealing with a little thing in your life, or at work, or within your marriage. Maybe you've taken some small liberties you shouldn't have taken. Then you nurture the little thing. You feed it. A curiosity turns into a fascination. A fascination turns into a habit. A habit becomes an addiction. And one day, you discover that your 'little liberty' has turned into a full-blown giant. Are there 'baby giants' in your life today? Make this commitment: 'Do not give the devil a foothold' Ephesians 4:27. Right now."
