



June 2026 Debt/Bank Loan for Worship Center, Music Center and Kid City



Originally the Loan was \$1,829,853.44 in November 2016 The Loan is now \$429,589.00 as of September 30, 2023.

FBC Endowment, a support organization of First Baptist Church of Tempe, services the National Bank of Arizona loan out of \$13,500.00 monthly payment from the church. With an additional \$24,000.00 of contributions each year, that loan would be fully paid off in May 2026. (And by the end of that year, a secondary loan of \$110,000.00 would also be paid off.)
Payments of \$13,500 per month (\$162,000.00) can then be used to support other ministries of the church!

FBC Expenses, Donations and Budgets

1. Pray for the planning of our 2024 Church Budget.

With our current donation shortfall unless donations significantly go up we likely will reduce the budget by around \$228,000 which would include a reduction of ministry dollars, a reduction in staff salaries and adjusted job descriptions.

2. *Praise God* - our donations so far this year are higher than our expenses by \$35,668. Our year-to-date General Fund donations are \$883,014.00 and our year-to-date expenses are \$847,346.00. Thank you!!!!!!

3. *Every donation dollar is appreciated and protected*. We receive many positive comments about the ministries of FBCT.

4. *Every donation dollar goes to meet the basic needs of FBC* not extravagant wants.

5. We never deficit spend - *We keep our expenses in line with our donations*.

6. Our *budgeted missionaries are being paid 100 percent* of their budgeted amount. Our *Faith Promise missionaries are being paid at 80 percent* of our Faith Promise amount due to decreased donations.

7. *Our 2023 donations are below the 2023 budget by 20 percent* or \$199,860.00. Our year-to-date budget is \$1,082,874.00 and our year-to-date donations are \$883,014.00.

8. *Pray for wisdom in planning the 2024 Proposed Budget and Faith Promise giving*. We are not able to hire new staff members out of the budget unless donations increase. We will continue budgeting four fulltime pastors, one full-time administrative staff member, a hand full of parttime staff members and welcome and celebrate a host of volunteers.

9. *Pray as we continue to reduce the bank debt on our building through the Support Organization, FBC Endowment.* It is possible to pay off the bank debt in June 2026 through budgeted funds and extra annual giving of \$24,000.00. Thank you for making extra donations for debt reduction to FBC Tempe Legacy.

10. *Pray for donations to exceed our budget* in order to continue advancing the gospel of Jesus Chris



In addition to our budgeted giving to missionaries, our Faith Promise giving is trusting God to enable us to give more money to missionaries above and beyond our FBC Budget. Through Faith Promise we support more missionaries to get out the news of Jesus Christ to people worldwide. We are trusting God to enable us to give in this way, however, our Faith Promise giving has consistently fallen 20% below in donations to our Faith Promise missionaries. In light of that, we have reduced our support by 20%. Please be praying about how you can support our FP missionaries. Your donation can be made out to FBCT and earmark it FP Missionaries.

2023 October God Stories

1. "When I follow Jesus I stay out of trouble. When I don't follow Jesus I get into all kinds of trouble." Two weeks ago, this college age man shared this with me and told me he wanted to get baptized because following Jesus would keep him out of trouble. Let's pray for this young man to follow Jesus and stay out of trouble.

2. "50 years ago I attended FBCT she said to me." I said welcome back. Glad to have you back. This lady has now attended our church the last four Sundays. Thank you Lord for your oversight and care for her. Praise God. Pray for God to bless her. Let's welcome her and any new face.

3.Our church plant Pastor says, "My wife and I, along with our two kids, Monty and Miriam, would go once or sometimes twice a week to the Guadalupe Public Library to partake in their summer activities for families. We wanted to establish familiarity with families and see what God is doing, and to have fun of course. When it came time to do outreach for the alpha/youth nights, we invited youth at the Guadalupe Library to come. This went well and the library staff had already recognized my wife and I. They were open to me passing out flyers for youth night. At first, I didn't think that the youth from the library would come to the alpha/youth group, they seemed to have rushed over from the library to the Mercado. The first youth meeting was 4 kids, then by the 3rd meeting we had 9 youth showing up. Now that school has started for some of them, they still want to continue meeting throughout the school year!

4.On the same Sunday in August three different ladies who recently started attending our church, individually, said they were struggling, lonely and searching for friends. Two weeks later each lady was involved in a small group bible study and building friendships. It is exciting to see people building friendships in the name of Jesus. Each one of us needs more friends in the name of Jesus.

5."I am renewing my faith in Jesus can I get baptized?" I said yes. Pray for this person who recently started attending our church. God is at work.

6.Grow your faith. Walk where Jesus walked. 62 people are now registered for our March 2024 trip to Israel to walk in Cana where Jesus turned the water into wine. You can visit Nazareth, the home town of Jesus. Imagine Jesus walking on water as we ride a boat on the Sea of Galilee. Walk in

Capernaum where Jesus performed miracles. Stand on the Mount of Olives and walk to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus was betrayed and arrested. Our next trip to Israel is March 2025. See Pastor Roger.

7.My mom came to church with me he said to me. Now my wife, my mom and I attend this church. God brought this family to our church. Pray for this new family of three to follow Jesus, find new friends and swerve Jesus.

8.Sixty years in the making. Fay Bachman was eight when God used a missionary to plant a seed in her. Memorial Day weekend 2022, a friend shared with Fay about medical mission trips to give free medical, dental, and spiritual care. Fay says, "After being excited, fearful, and praying, I felt God giving me peace to go. I was accepted to go with a medical team!" Since May 2022 Fay has been to Zanzibar (August 2022), Tanzania (January 2023), Malawi (August 2023) - all are countries in Africa. Fay says, "I realized I not only enjoy working in this type of medical environment, but it truly is a passion of my heart to help others around the world medically and spiritually." Each patient Fay works with is given the opportunity to be prayed for, have the 4 spiritual laws explained, and be connected to the local church. This 60-year-old dream would not be possible without the prayers and financial support of FBC-T, family, and friends.

9.Please pray for my husband Bob. His salvation and our marriage for deliverance from alcohol. Please LORD GOD restore my marriage. I need a miracle. Thank you. (This message came from our church website as a prayer request.)

10."Stick with Jesus who is God. Obey Jesus because Jesus gives freedom, hope and community". Never forget these words from Pastor Tom Croke. Pray for Pastor Tom and his wife Sherice and their newborn.

11.The Grandmother (Linda) drops off a brother and sister for alpha/youth night, and Lee picks them up. Linda told our church plant Pastor that she attended my sister Naomi's funeral service this year at FBC of Tempe. Linda mentioned that she was moved by the service. A seed was planted then, and it is growing. God is at work with this family.

12. **One particular youth night** we showed a video that had evangelical messaging from Billy Graham that was well received by the youth. There was a part of the video that covered the 'sinner's prayer'. In that segment of the sinner's prayer, as Graham was leading the prayer we heard

whispers coming from one side of the table – a couple of the youth were saying the sinner's prayer underneath their breath. Peter Molina our church plant Pastor says, "My wife and I are now seeing that the youth are further along in their spiritual development, there's a harvest here that is ready - we need workers! We need a team - please pray.

13.Special. ASU just offered our military-PHD-Chaplain Rick Brennan and opportunity join ASU in research writing on moral injury. Pray for Rick.

14. "John 3:16 and the ABC's of becoming a Christian" - In our church plant the Alpha/Youth Nights in Guadalupe are held on Fridays at 4:30pm, in the Multi-Purpose community Room. One Friday, Trish Molina wanted to teach the youth how to locate a verse in the Bible. We started with John 3:16. This seemed to be the one activity where the kids were most engaged. Through this process, they quickly learned about the Old Testament and New Testament, the 12 Disciples and why they were called Disciples, and of course how to use the 'table of contents'. Ultimately, they read John 3:16 aloud, and we talked about the ABC's of becoming a Christian. They had deep questions and although none accepted Christ right then, we could tell that God was on their minds and seeds were planted. We ended that day with a water-balloon fight/games. This time, after the youth group had ended, the kids stayed to hang-out with us at the Mercado. They asked us questions about what's next. They want to continue the group, even when they're all back in school. Pray for our church plant.
