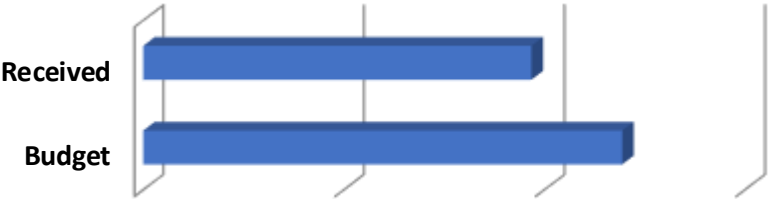

Let's Help Families in Need this Upcoming Holiday Season

There are families in our church who face many “monthly painful challenges.” Hardship has become a way of life for these families. But all of these families serve God with a smile among us. They work hard.

They purpose to pay their bills on time. Lazy, no. No scams here. But no savings. Some families are younger. Some are older. Red, yellow, black and white and they all need some help during the holidays. Some families struggle every month to make medical payments on major medical expenses. Some families work part-time as they constantly look for full-time employment. From big families to families of one. Some face the loss of their rental home and some contemplate being homeless. Some live paycheck to paycheck on part-time wages. Some walk or ride the bus. Some families have one car. Some have no insurance.

We would like to help 20 low income families in our church with some extra money at Thanksgiving or at Christmas. If you know of a family who is facing some special needs, please contact Pastor and give him your recommendation.

Church Action Meeting

The results of the Church Action Meeting last Sunday, October 15, 2023, is that the Proposed 2024 General Fund Budget and the Proposed 2024 Faith Promise Giving had a nearly unanimous approval.

We are praising God for providing this past year in such a way that we did not have to spend more than what we received in donations and we are praying that future donations will exceed our budget in order to continue to advance the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

June 2026 Debt/Bank Loan for Worship Center, Music Center and Kid City



Originally the Loan was \$1,829,853.44 in November 2016
The Loan is now \$429,589.00 as of September 30, 2023.

FBC Endowment, a support organization of First Baptist Church of Tempe, services the National Bank of Arizona loan out of \$13,500.00 monthly payment from the church. With an additional \$24,000.00 of contributions each year, that loan would be fully paid off in May 2026. (And by the end of that year, a secondary loan of \$110,000.00 would also be paid off.) Payments of \$13,500 per month (\$162,000.00) can then be used to support other ministries of the church!

10. **God walks and holds her hands as she climbs mountains!**

FBC-T Administrative Assistant Pam Rosendale has climbed many steep mountains in the last seven weeks. Pam was diagnosed with squamous cell cancer. She had surgery for it on August 14. Then on August 21 she went into the hospital with blood clots. After blood thinners and a surgery part of a blood clot made it way to her right knee. After three more surgeries, the decision was made to remove her right leg above the knee. God was there climbing these mountains. October 3, after weeks of mountains Pam has a new one to climb - she returned home to a new and different life. Pam writes, "Adjusting your whole life is frightening and overwhelming. Good news there is a way! Lord, I am tired. Please give me courage to make the necessary changes." Please pray for Pam! Pray for strength and courage.

11. **Thy Word have I hidden in my heart** That is what our Kid City children are doing. Each week children of all ages (from 2-years-old to 6th grade) work on memorizing a Bible verse in Sunday School and between services. This is a joint effort with our Kid City teachers and parents. Parents and grade school kids work on the verses each week from 10:30 - 11:00 a.m. And, teachers work with preschool children during class to help them understand what they are memorizing. Father Stephen Tunnicliff writes, "It was so exciting to see my son learning Scripture at such a young age (3 yrs old). I firmly believe that parents need to teach our children the importance of Scripture and appreciate that FBC helps us to reinforce that." Isn't that amazing. Great job! Great team work! Please pray for our teachers and parents as they team up to teach God's Word to our children. Great job!

3. **God blesses a young mom!** Recently, a very excited young Mom came to me. God had answered a specific prayer. Some time ago she was abused by a drunk man. He was arrested and found guilty. She was asked to give a victim's impact statement during his sentencing. Her husband accompanied her to court and it was difficult seeing her attacker. But God was with her. She went to the podium and through the tears she was able to make her statement. When asked if he wanted to make a statement, the attacker turned and apologized. Rejoice with this closed story. Praising God with her.

4. **Free Bible given to Army Mom.** A lady came to the church looking for a Bible. She is from Iowa and returning today. Her son, who lives here is being deployed in the Army to Syria tomorrow. She looked for a store that sold Bibles to buy one for her son. She couldn't find a store. She stopped by FBC and I gave her one. She was overjoyed. It is an emotional strain to watch your son go away to a war-torn country and she was obviously looking for various ways to support him. It was a sweet feeling to be able to help. Interesting after note: Another lady came in a few days later and wanted to donate a brand new Bible - it was the same version as the one given to the mother.
5. **"What a wonder** that here in my home in Missouri I can talk with Dwight who is now in a village in the middle of the jungle in Peru!" writes missionary Gwynne Shaver. She continues, "But what an even greater wonder it is that we who are only mortal can speak with our Eternal Father who made the heavens and the earth. And He can hear us. And he *wants* to hear us! And we can hear *Him* through His Word. What an amazing gift He has given us: His Word in our language! Oh that the people groups in Peru would soon be able to hear His kind words to them in their language. Thank you for praying that the Lord would multiply our feeble efforts."
6. **Twenty years of PROCLAIMING CHRIST** in a backyard. Every Christmas Pastor Roger and Dianna opened their home for Walk to Bethlehem, a yearly tradition for many families in the East Valley. The display told the story of Jesus' birth, death and resurrection. First time guests were so touched by a display reflecting the true meaning of Christmas. Over 700,000 people experienced this display which was created by FBC-T members and neighbors on Natal Circle. Each year around 60 people setup the display; about 250 hosted around the fire pit; and about 40 people dismantled and stored the display. God blessed FBC-T and its outreach for 20 years. You were faithful in proclaiming the Gospel in this unique and

creative manner. We regret that this tradition will not continue this Christmas.

7. **Teamwork is a key to successful ministry.** Our choir and orchestra had such an amazing weekend, August 26-27, 2023 with the combined choirs and orchestras of [First Baptist Church - Tempe](#) and First Southern Baptist Church of Scottsdale...and our new friends Daniel and Christy Semsen. Pastor Rob writes, "Last Sunday (August 20), I had the honor of leading the combined orchestras and choruses of First Baptist Tempe and First Southern Baptist of Scottsdale in a joint rehearsal in preparation for this concert (over 100 members). It was honestly the most fun musically I've had in years! What an honor to join together." Our choir and orchestra spent three evenings praising God with another choir. To say they filled our tank would be an understatement. THANKFUL for churches that are faithfully supporting and nurturing vibrant choirs.
8. **"Thank you for praying for the situation here,"** write missionaries Tom and Laura Requadt. At the moment things are relatively calm but in West Africa things change as quickly as the wind. Tom continues, "I have the joy to let you know that indeed we did finish the final read of Romans ... and have started on 1 Corinthians." Continue to pray for the Tom and Laura as they finish their assignments and prepare for their scheduled departure on November 20.
9. **"Table Talk" helps participants apply concepts to their lives.** The "Telling Yourself the Truth" class teacher was encouraged as many want to take the class again. The topics were all noteworthy, but the session on The Drama Triangle was a particular favorite. Each class had PowerPoint presentations which greatly enhanced the topics addressed. The major "problem" was there was not enough time for each topic. Teacher Lee Henkelman writes, "It was a joy to lead the class in such a life enhancing study." The word of God was central to each class with appropriate Bible references. That was also a favorite part of the class. There were handouts for each
