“Devotion to Prayer”

Colossians 4:2-4

Are you satisfied with your prayer life? One survey of 860 church pastors alleges that only 16% are very satisfied with their personal prayer lives. 47% are somewhat satisfied, 30% somewhat dissatisfied and 7% very dissatisfied. In this passage, Paul is teaching the believers in Colossians certain principles on Christian Living, one of those principles is a life “Devoted to Prayer”! So can one be devoted to prayer, the following should prove helpful.

Sermon Outline

1. By Being Committed to Prayer.

- a. “...pray without ceasing” (1 Thessalonians 5:16)

2. By Being Thankful when Praying.

- a. “Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you” – (1 Thessalonians 5:18)

3. By Praying for Others.

- a. “At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ” – (Colossians 4:3)

4. By Praying for the Sharing and Advancement of the Gospel.

- a. “Do you not say, ‘There are yet four months, then comes the harvest’? Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest.” – John 4:35
