4. The Church's team Comprises of Servants of Christ

- a. Col. 4:7 - “faithful servant and fellow bond-servant in the Lord.”

5. The Church's Team is Made up of Imperfect People

- a. 2 Tim. 4:11 - “Only Luke is with me. Pick up Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful to me for service.”
