



# A Christmas Tradition

#### Candle Two Equals Bethlehem (Second Week of Advent) Micah 5:2 and John 6:35

The second candle represents faith and is called "Bethlehem's Candle." Micah had foretold that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem, which is also the birthplace of King David. This candle reminds of the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem.

The old, beautiful city of Bethlehem is surrounded by barren, unproductive regions – the wilderness of the Sinai and the mountains of Moab. Bethlehem means, "the house of bread." God chose this insignificant village as the birthplace of His Son.

Bread has long been a staple food for the human race, Leavened and unleavened, it is mentioned many times in Scripture. When the Israelite slaves had to free Egypt, they ate unleavened bread that they could prepare quickly. During their wandering in the desert on the way to the Promised Land, God showered heavenly bread on their encampments: manna. During His final Passover Supper with the disciples, Jesus used bread as an illustration of Himself. He said that He was "the Bread of Life." What does this mean to us? Even as bread sustains physical life, Jesus can bring us life, strength and satisfaction when we have faith in Him.

# December 2023 God Stories Love Came Down!

- 1. Needs are being met by FBCT showing practical love. Every year FBCT collects money to help families during Thanksgiving and Christmas. We have already helped several families! You, too, can help families this Christmas season by giving to FBC-T and earmarking the gift Christmas.
- 2. God's love is seen in His character. FBCT's missionary Ben Joseph told us to focus on God's character when facing the storms of life. God is faithful and He never changes. As you pray to God, His peace changes you. Ben wrote a book, Dancing Through Sorrow. Ben and his wife Aleyamma face new challenges in their life. Aleyamma is struggling with her immediate memory. Pray that God gives both of them strength, patience and peace as they walk through this new challenge. C.S. Lewis wrote, "God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks to us in our conscience, but shouts in our pain. It is His megaphone to rouse a deaf world."
- 3. Love requires parents and teens respect each other. Students and parents enjoyed a night of pizza and *Spider-Man: Across the Spider-Verse*, followed by a discussion on the film's messaging. This film wrestles with the teen/parent relationship. Parents were encouraged to remind the teen who he is, how much he is loved, and how they have to trust him with his own decisions (after giving him a good foundation). Teens were encouraged to remember who they are, where they come from, who truly has their best interest at heart (their parents), and doing the right thing over what everyone else is telling them to do. Themes of honoring your parents, being truthful, and being a person of good character are biblical ethics.

- 4. Faithful servant helps you worship a God who loves sacrificially. Sally Compton has faithfully volunteered in our Worship Ministry for many years! Weekly she serves on the piano/organ and is a regular accompanist for our choir. Many don't realize that accompanying choirs and orchestras requires a specific and distinct skill set. She dedicates her time to our weekly rehearsals, choir/orchestra retreats, and concerts. We are thrilled that Sally is a part of our team; we could not do what we do without her!
- 5. FBC Students created imago dei in the image of LOVE! Students attended a conference to help them to better understand what it means to be created in the image of God, imago dei. The speakers reminded students that to be an imagebearer is to have intrinsic, God-given value, and that their identity is not in their gender, sexual orientation, or anything other than who they are in Christ. They mentioned that even those outside of the faith share His image, and are therefore deserving of being treated with dignity and care, as Jesus perfectly displayed.
- 6. **Over 5,000 views each week on Facebook give people a midweek spiritual pick-me-up.** They view Pastor Roger's weekly Walk and Talk. And, each week there are over 900 through plays. Wow! God is blessing His Word. What began as an informal way for Pastor Roger to connect with the FBCT family during the COVID shut down has become a significant ministry. Missionary Shelby Webb writes, "In a society where women are valued very little, let alone, own anything of significance that belongs to them, I was able to give 4 audio bibles with the Bible teaching loaded on it to these ladies! Their very own - let that sink in!!! They faithfully come to every lesson and faithfully hear God's Word being taught! I encouraged them to play the lessons at night to their children and anyone that walks by and wants to hear. God's Word continues to go forth....so thank you to those that have given specifically for Bibles, audio Bibles and glasses! #### 10. A mother's love teaches God's character to her children. A

mother of teens says, "Every day I ask my kids 2 questions:

- 1. What is one thing you learned today?
- 2. How did you see God working today?

My young teen texted me after school today and said, "I won't have time to talk to you today before your Bible study so I'm gonna answer your questions now. 1) I learned that you get threatened with detention if you're 1 minute late because you're in the bathroom and 2) I saw God work because I didn't get detention for being 1 minute late to class"

- 11. Love builds community in creative ways. Trunk or Treat on October 29 had excellent attendance of kids and adults and over 23 trunks. Praise God for building community with open trunks and a little candy.
- 12. One Life One Purpose reflects God's love for us and for others! Philippians 2:3 was the key verse for our Sunday, October 22 Compassion Day. Everyone kindergarten through 99 met together to participate in an all-church Compassion Day. All were challenged to live with one life purpose – to consider others more important than yourself. We worshipped together and served together. Our compassion project was Samaritan's Purse's Operation Christmas Child Shoebox Outreach. We collected 330 boxes and \$1,500 to mail the boxes for children around the world.
- 13. When you love, you want people to know. Five people declared their love for Jesus by being baptised on November 5. Susan Glendy, Ron Glendy, Kobe Garcia, Anastasia Kyetemteng, and Andy Brennan were baptized declaring their faith in the power of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- 14. How many "God loving" volunteers does it take to setup, implement and tear down Walk to Bethlehem? Each year for the past twenty years, 60+ individuals faithfully setup the display. Another 120 people hosted WTB each Thanksgiving night to Christmas Eve night. Then, each January about 30 people dismantled the display and stored it. Each year approximately 210 volunteers were needed for Walk to Bethlehem. For years, 70+ FBC tech, orchestra and choir held Christmas concerts on Natal Circle. Others served hot chocolate and hot apple cider to concert goers. Thank you for your sacrifice. This wonderful ministry came to a conclusion in December 2022.
