

June 2026 Debt/Bank Loan for Worship Center, Music Center and Kid City



Originally the Loan was \$1,829,853.44 in November 2016 The Loan is now \$365,563 as of December 31, 2023.

FBC Endowment, a support organization of First Baptist Church of Tempe, services the National Bank of Arizona loan out of \$13,500.00 monthly payment from the church. With an additional \$24,000.00 of contributions each year, that loan would be fully paid off in May 2026. (And by the end of that year, a secondary loan of \$110,000.00 would also be paid off.)

Will you join us in praying over the search for a new Senior Pastor for FBC?

Our Pastoral Search Team has created the following suggestions as you pray during this time of searching.

- 1. **Prepare Your Heart:** Begin by finding a quiet and peaceful place to pray. Take a moment to calm your mind and focus your thoughts on the task at hand.
- Express Gratitude: Start your prayer by expressing gratitude for your current senior pastor and for the church community as a whole. Acknowledge the importance of their role in guiding the congregation.
- 3. **Seek Guidance:** Pray for guidance in the selection process. Ask for wisdom and discernment for the church leadership, search committee, and anyone involved in the decision-making process. Pray that they may be led by the Holy Spirit to choose a pastor who aligns with the church's mission and values.
- 4. **Pray for the Candidates**: Lift up the potential candidates for the senior pastor position. Pray that God will provide clarity and direction to those who are considering this role. Ask that they may have a heart for service and a deep desire to lead and shepherd the congregation.
- 5. **Pray for Qualities:** Specifically, pray for the qualities and attributes you believe are important in a senior pastor, such as spiritual maturity, integrity, humility, effective communication, and a heart for pastoral care.
- 6. **Unity:** Pray for unity within the congregation during this process. Ask that any differences of opinion or division may be resolved in a spirit of love and unity.
- 7. **Timing:** Pray that God's timing will be perfect in this selection process, and that the right person will come forward at the right time.
- 8. **Commitment:** Pray for the new senior pastor's commitment to faithfully serve the church and its members, and that they may find joy and fulfillment in their role.
- 9. **Blessing:** Finally, ask for God's blessings upon the chosen pastor, that they may have a fruitful ministry and be a source of spiritual growth and inspiration for the congregation.
- 10. Amen: Conclude your prayer with a heartfelt "Amen", sealing your request in faith, knowing that God hears your prayers and will guide FBC in the selection of a senior pastor.

January 2024 God Stories

Philippians 1:6 GNT, "And so I am sure that God, who began this good work in you, will carry it on until it is finished on the Day of Christ Jesus."

- 1. **Praise God** for the 18 (eighteen) passionate missionary families signed-up to be in our church between January 21 and February 15. Each Sunday for six back-to-back Sundays, we will host three five different missionaries. These missionaries plan to share about their exciting ministries in our Sunday Bible Classes and in our Worship Services. **TOGETHER**, we **Build God's Kingdom**.
- 2. *High School Students Set for Mission Field!* FBCT students Becca Blum, Josiah Lemons, Emma Malmin, and Anya Sorbo are headed on short-term mission's trips in 2024. They join others from VCHS as part of their Spring Break. Becca has raised 100% of her needed funds. Praise God! Pray for these students. God may be preparing a career missionary, an evangelist, a children's director, a women's ministries director. This time of serving and discipleship will change their lives.
- 3. How long does it take to build the foundation? Ryan & Shelby Webb began their foundation in Papua New Guinea with language training 16 years ago. Soon thereafter they arrived on the island and began to build relationships with the Manam people. They lived life with them: experiencing births and deaths, volcanoes erupting, adverse weather conditions, and life in general. In 2022 Ryan began writing lessons on the major Bible stories from Genesis to Revelation. Finally, in June 2023, Ryan began teaching the Manam people from the lessons he wrote. Pray for the Webb family as they live life on an island and share Jesus with the Manam people.

"Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." 2Cor 9:7

- 4. Wild and wacky FBCT junior high directors Jeff and Beth HAuse became missionaries in Bolivia in 1991. God used Jeff and Beth as they faithfully proclaimed Jesus in many creative ways while raising 4 children. Beth joined the Lord in 2019 after a long battle with a chronic infection. Jeff continues to serve as a missionary in Santa Cruz, Bolivia. In May, the four-year anniversary of Beth's death, the Beth HAuse Counseling Room was dedicated. The Counseling Room benefits Proclama, a ministry that Beth participated in and which helps the Bolivian church in understanding and fulfilling its role in the Great Commission. The room is also used for counseling, mentoring, discipleship and meetings. Ask Jeff on January 21 why he and Beth might be considered wild and wacky.
- 5. *Celebrating 35 years* of serving Christ with Greater European Missions is a sign of real commitment. They began their ministry in Latvia and ended it in Frankfort, Germany. Bernie was a mission coach, church planting researcher and strategist. Mary served in their church women's ministry by mentoring young mothers and supporting women who were dealing with emotional trauma. Mary experienced God's faithfulness over the years. They are adjusting as they retire from ministry. As they transition, they can see God working by providing a new vehicle, setting up new phones, updating contacts on accounts, and visiting doctors/dentists. Please, pray for Bernie and Mary as they are experiencing culture shock and grieve leaving friends and ministry partners in Europe. When you see them at FBCT on Sunday, January 28, ask them to share some examples of how God has used them over the years.
- 6. God Spreads His Love to His FBCT Children. Families gathered in the FBCT gym on December 3 to eat lunch together and then to build gingerbread houses together. You could hear families talking and laughing together as children, moms and dads, and grandparents built their houses. There were some very creative houses. All 150 enjoyed the afternoon and felt Jesus' love. Sometimes, it is easy to be a missionary and share God's love.

- 7. **God Uses YOU** to reduce FBCT's \$1.8 million long-term debt that was encountered when building the worship center, music center, and Kid City. From November 2022 to November2023 YOU contributed \$302,872 toward the reduction of this long-term debt. Now our long-term debt balance is \$377,727. Praise God!! To help reduce this debt earmark your donation "Legacy".
- 8. So, your husband's a missionary! Each missionary spouse is a missionary in their own right. Some teach with their husbands, others show hospitality to those served, others teach children and teens but all spouses serve with their husbands. Al Fadi's sweet wife has a servant's heart. She hosts many in their home for prayer, mission's conferences, and Bible studies. She serves as a deaconess. Pastor Al has an aggressive schedule traveling all over the world to speak at conferences and churches. While gone, Mrs. Fadi holds down the fort while raising their two children.
- 9. **Broken Family Relationships Are Devastating.** An FBCT grandmother has been estranged from her son's family for over 10 years. Heart-broken, she tried to restore the relationships. Recently, her 18-year-old granddaughter called her and asked to see her. The grandmother enjoyed a Sunday lunch and an afternoon of shopping with her two granddaughters. This grandmother's heart is overflowing with love and gratitude. Praise God for restored relationships and His love and mercy.
- 10. *Third Generation Missionary* Andrea Combs serves with her husband Hunter in a very diverse culture. Their focus group is Muslims. Andrea and Hunter have three small children. The opportunities are vast, and the need is great. They believe that God is calling them to evangelize the lost, to equip leaders, and to teach and train believers. They feel a strong call from the Lord to focus their efforts on winning Muslims to Christ.

- 11. International Students Gather in the FBCT's Gym Each December. Our gym was filled with over 200 international students for a Christmas celebration dinner on December 8 put on by Campus Ambassadors. Missionaries Ben and Aleyamma Joseph have been missionaries since 1983 on the ASU campus. They have the opportunity to minister among the more than 15,000 students who have come to the U.S. from over 140 different nations. Eight percent of these students are from the 10/40 window, the least evangelized parts of the world. Ben says, "America is fortunate to have the world come to her a foreign mission field at her door step. There may be no better opportunity for world evangelization than that of reaching international students for Jesus Christ." Contact Ben to volunteer in this important ministry.
- 12. Friends Drive the Extra Mile. "Last month a friend and two other ladies set out on an adventure in her motorhome. The motorhome over heated in Nevada and they called a tow truck to tow them into Las Vegas. The mechanic couldn't take care of the repair right away. The friends became sick with Covid and drove a rental car back to AZ. She was alone, broken and scared. I called to check on her. She was in despair. I told her my husband, Stan, would call the mechanic and that he would drive the RV to AZ. This reassured her that she was not alone. A happy ending: Stan drove the RV back and she was beyond grateful. I told her you need to come to church with us and she has been doing just that." God is powerful and always shows up in those who have a servant's heart.
- 13. Can You See the Smiles on Their Faces? Not only did our FBCT family provide Shoeboxes for children in other countries but we provided 100 gifts to children who have one or both parents incarcerated. Bruce Baird began planning for this ministry in September and it took a few months from the time Bruce began planning to the time the last gift was delivered in middle December. When the gifts were delivered Bruce and his helpers were greeted by big smiles. Thank you for serving God.
