



## **My Daily Walk With God**

Read Galatians 6:1-10  
and use the SPECK Bible Study Method.

- **Sins to avoid** – Make a list of known sins, wrong actions, attitudes or thoughts mentioned in this passage.
- **Promises to claim** – Make a list of all the promises in this passage. Take them to heart and believe what they say
- **Examples to follow** – What examples do you find in this passage? Is there a right way of thinking or acting described in the passage that you should take as an example for your life?
- **Commands to obey** – Write out all the commands you find. Take action if you can.
- **Knowledge of God to acquire** – What does the passage tell you about God or Jesus? List any facts you find.

## ACTS Prayers

Use this as a guide for your prayers this week:

- **Adoration-** Psalm 48:1, 9-10; Psalm 148
- **Confession-** Psalm 32:5; 1 John 1:9
- **Thanksgiving-** Psalm 118:28; 1 Corinthians 1:4
- **Supplication-** Philippians 5:6, Matthew 6:9-13

### Four R's – The Gift of Repentance

If you are stuck in the guilt of sin, use the four R's this week to walk through repentance.

1. Repent of the sin (Acts 3:19)
2. Receive God's forgiveness (1 John 1:9)
3. Rebuke the enemy's hold on you because of sin (James 4:7)
4. Replace all lies with God's Truth (Galatians 2:20)

**Passage to Memorize- II Timothy 3:16-17** – *“All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.”*
